

The New Bloomfield Village Road Committee
Bloomfield Village Board Report ~ Update
November 15, 2015

1. The New Bloomfield Village Road Committee has prepared a mailing for the Village residents requesting the signed return of the Road Commission of Oakland County (RCOC) Expression of Interest form.

2. Thank you for the various late recommendations to the letter and the Q&A... The committee will be incorporating your suggestions into their future communications through the Bloomfield Village Website and the Bulletin.

3. The committee welcomes all Questions and is offering some members to field answers. It is our recommendation that the Village residents first contact their District Trustees or Art... who will each be provided a list of committee members in order to refer the residents if you are not able to answer their question(s).

The handout is a current list of committee members, and where there are phone numbers, these members have currently offered to be available to answer questions.

4. Please note that our current goal is to simply receive 51% interest from our village residents so that the RCOC will commence a FREE engineering study to determine our road conditions and possible improvement options... There are NO costs, No binding interest, and NO road improvement options for any decisions at this time.

If residents call with complicated questions... please try to keep it simple and to this point. We are at the beginning stages of research.

Note: Cranbrook, Covington and parts of Glengarry will not be included in an RCOC engineering study, yet they are to be informed and the RCOC confirmed that it is fine if they submit the form.

5. Committee members plan to meet with Art later this week in order to update the 'Road' tab on the Bloomfield Village website with minutes, Q&A's and any other pertinent information. We plan to update the website periodically, as we do not want to incur unnecessary expenses from the contracted Webmaster.

6. Regarding our committee expenses: We purchased (1,000) stamps for \$980 and (1,000) #9 & #10 envelopes and 4 reams of paper & labels for \$150, totaling \$1,130... which has been submitted for reimbursement. Ron Ross graciously orchestrated obtaining all of the materials & the preparation for the mailing, volunteering his company... Thank you, Ron and Art and all our committee members!
