

The New Bloomfield Village Road Committee
October 2015 Minutes

Tuesday, October 20, 2015 ~ Hackett Hall 7:00pm

Sean Metrose, representing our committee as Chairman, gave an informative and thorough presentation for our voluntary New Bloomfield Village Road Committee (NBVRC) to the monthly Bloomfield Village Board of Trustees meeting. He summarized our August and September meetings, presented the RCOC and Bloomfield Township information and potential participation, and discussed the Expression of Interest as a first step in the process toward improving our village roads. The Bloomfield Village Board members were approving of the presentation, made constructive suggestions, and informed us of the \$10,000 set aside in the current budget to pursue the improvement of our roads. The Board voted to give our committee \$1,000 of this budget amount toward our Expression of Interest mailing to the Bloomfield Village residents.

The committee met to discuss an Expression of Interest to submit to the RCOC. This form requires (1) Bloomfield Village resident signature per household to show 'Interest' in road improvement for our Village roads. The goal is to collect 51% 'Interest' from each street. Although 3 Bloomfield Village roads (Cranbrook, Covington and parts of Glengarry) have or are currently receiving road improvements from State and Local funds due to special circumstances, the residents on these roads may receive our NBVRC correspondence. This information has since been confirmed by the RCOC.

The correspondence will require a cover letter, a Q&A page to be on the back of the cover letter, and the actual Expression of Interest form previously submitted to our NBVRC. We suggested including a self-addressed stamped envelope for reply convenience. We plan to have this correspondence ready for mailing before the next Bloomfield Village Board meeting in November.
